

Verano Resident's Council Meeting 5/11/09

- Update from Meeting with Housing:
 - The amount of funds currently left in the Verano Resident's Council budget still need to be tallied and should be available soon.
 - There are still issues with getting a new igniter for the barbeque grill next to the Commons, we are now looking at the possibility of getting a universal igniter that would call for a modification of the currently installed grill.
 - Officer Monsanto from the UCI Police Department came to talk with us about ticketing and safety issues in Verano.
 - Residents need to be aware that Verano parking lots are considered public roads not private driveways thus any violation that one could be ticketed for while driving one can be ticketed for while parked in Verano (ex. out of date vehicle registration tags).
 - Residents should also be aware of the fact that parking violations are tied to their UCI accounts thus unpaid tickets can result in such actions as transcript holds.
 - The three individuals responsible for vehicle break-ins in the upper Verano lots have been captured.
 - Communication with residents regarding crime in the neighborhood will be on-going.
 - This year residents will not be required to provide copies of their registration to the Verano Housing Office.
